LEFT onto US-19N / COCHRAN RD / YELLOW BELT  
Turn RIGHT onto BEVERLY RD / US-19N  
Turn LEFT onto MCFARLAND RD / US-19N. Continue to follow US-19N  
Merge onto I-279 N / US-22 E / US-30 E  
Merge onto I-376 E / US-22 E / US-30 E via EXIT 6A toward MONROEVILLE  
Take EXIT 5 toward HOMESTEAD / SQUIRREL HILL  
Turn LEFT onto FORWARD AVE  
Stay STRAIGHT to go onto MURRAY AVE  
End at 1922 Murray Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15217



### From the North:

Take I-79 S  
Keep LEFT to take I-279 S via EXIT 72 toward PITTSBURGH  
Merge onto I-579 S via EXIT 8A toward VETERANS BRIDGE  
Take the exit toward I-376 E / OAKLAND / MONROEVILLE  
Stay STRAIGHT to go onto BOULEVARD OF THE ALLIES  
Merge onto I-376 E / US-22 E / US-30 E toward MONROEVILLE  
Take EXIT 5 toward HOMESTEAD / SQUIRREL HILL  
Turn LEFT onto FORWARD AVE  
Stay STRAIGHT to go onto MURRAY AVE  
End at 1922 Murray Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15217

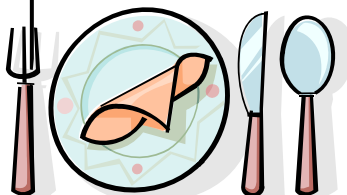
### From the West:

Merge onto PA-60 BR / AIRPORT PKWY / ORANGE BELT  
Merge onto PA-60 S  
Merge onto US-22 E / US-30 E  
Merge onto I-376 E / US-22 E / US-30 E via EXIT 6A toward MONROEVILLE  
Take EXIT 5 toward HOMESTEAD / SQUIRREL HILL  
Turn LEFT onto FORWARD AVE  
Stay STRAIGHT to go onto MURRAY AVE  
End at 1922 Murray Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15217



### From the East:

Take I-376 W / US-22 W toward PITTSBURGH  
Take EXIT 5 toward HOMESTEAD / SQUIRREL HILL  
Turn LEFT onto FORWARD AVE  
Stay STRAIGHT to go onto MURRAY AVE  
End at 1922 Murray Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15217
